From the Minister:

One of the good opportunities that comes through being minister here is the chance for close co-operation and work with local schools. In common with the other clergy in the town I am privileged to take assemblies and special services regularly in the schools and we welcome school parties on visits to the churches quite frequently. From the start of the new year up to half term I have conducted assembly four times in different schools, which is the usual rate at which these occur, and also took part in a large ecumenical service for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity at St Mary's High School attended by all the local secondary schools which was a very successful occasion. It is really encouraging to see not only all the local clergy and churches co-operate together but also be welcomed into the schools so warmly and regularly.

The latest school related project is one organised by the Down County Museum Peace III project in which all the local clergy have been interviewed, on film, about the beliefs, practices and histories of their congregations. These will be edited together to form a teaching aid available on DVD for all schools. So it is nice to be involved in such projects and good to know that our tradition is a part of them.

Again I would like to thank all our visiting preachers – particularly Sue Steers, Very Rev Bill McMillan, Rev Dr Will Patterson, and Rev Bill Haslett who have all taken services recently.

Once again congratulations go to Sue Steers who has been accepted to train for the ministry by the Presbytery of Antrim. We wish Sue every success in this work. It is very pleasing too to welcome Ruth Rooney to the role of secretary of the Clough congregation, having taken over from Pearl Shaw who retired at the end of last year.
