#### From the Minister:

I have spoken in the churches about my visit to Romania and there is a bit more inside this Calendar, particularly about the Church Torockó with which we are establishing a partnership. But the main reason for my visit was to attend the 450th anniversary celebrations of the Edict of Torda. Put simply this was a very early expression – in 1568 – of the principles of religious toleration. As such it does deserve to be far more widely known. We still see all around the world so many instances of intolerance and repression but the Edict, promulgated by the diet (or parliament) of King John II Sigismund, said simply: "No one shall be reviled for his religion by anyone, for faith is the gift of God." These words are inscribed on the new memorial unveiled on 13th January in the small town of Torda. I was very pleased to be present for its unveiling.

There are a number of important events coming up in the churches in the forthcoming period of Lent and Easter please make a note of them and give them your support.

A big thank you also to all our visiting preachers over the last few months which has included Rev Dr Will Patterson, Rev Ernie Boggs, Rev William Haslett, Sue Steers and David McCord.

These pictures cover (in order) the service to commemorate the 450<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Edict of Torda, the cathedral of Gyulafehérvár (where King John Sigismund is buried), and Kolozsvár, the main city of Transylvania. But most of the pictures I have shown in the churches have related to the Church in Torockó with which we are developing a partnership. I was delighted to spend a night there in the beautifully restored manse with the minister, the Rev Márton Csésc, in the historic village of Torockó. The Unitarian Church there dates from 1670 and the congregation is well-supported by the population of the village. We look forward to developing our friendship with congregation in the days ahead.
