This is to Commemorate the Centenary of the end of the First World War and dedicate the new Roll of Honour for denomination which will published on that day. Everyone who attends the service will receive a complimentary copy of the Roll of Honour (which contains 588 names of those who served plus biographies of 98 servicemen who gave their lives).
